


Using the Zulu Desktop Client

Download the desktop client

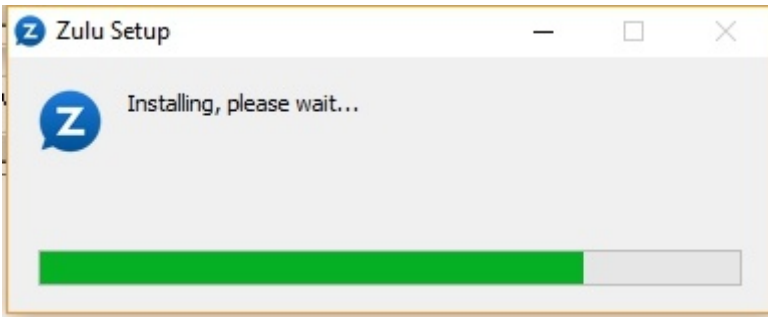

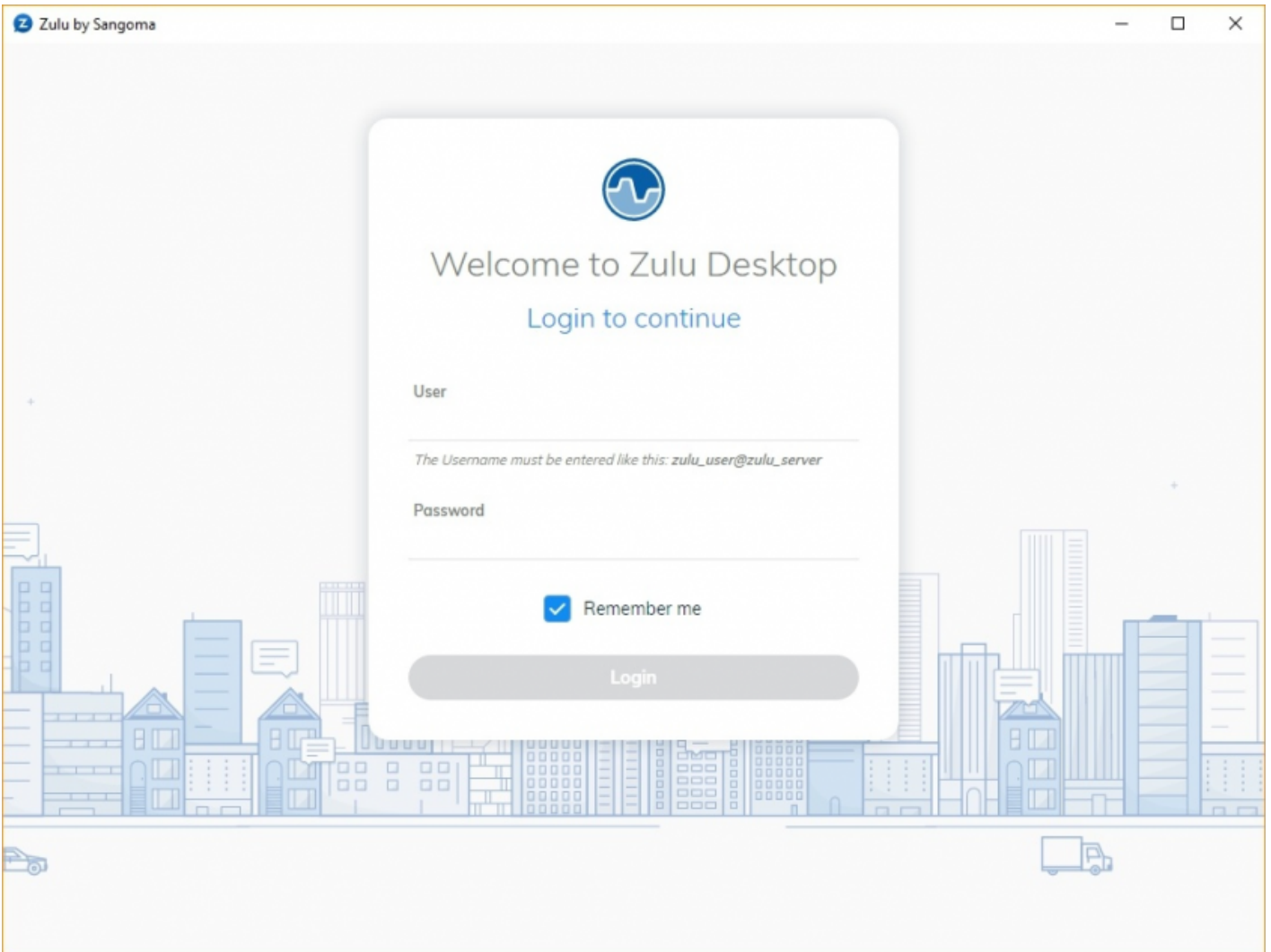
Navigate to <https://zulu-updater.sangoma.com/releases/stable> and download the current desktop application for your given platform.

After installation it will prompt you to login.

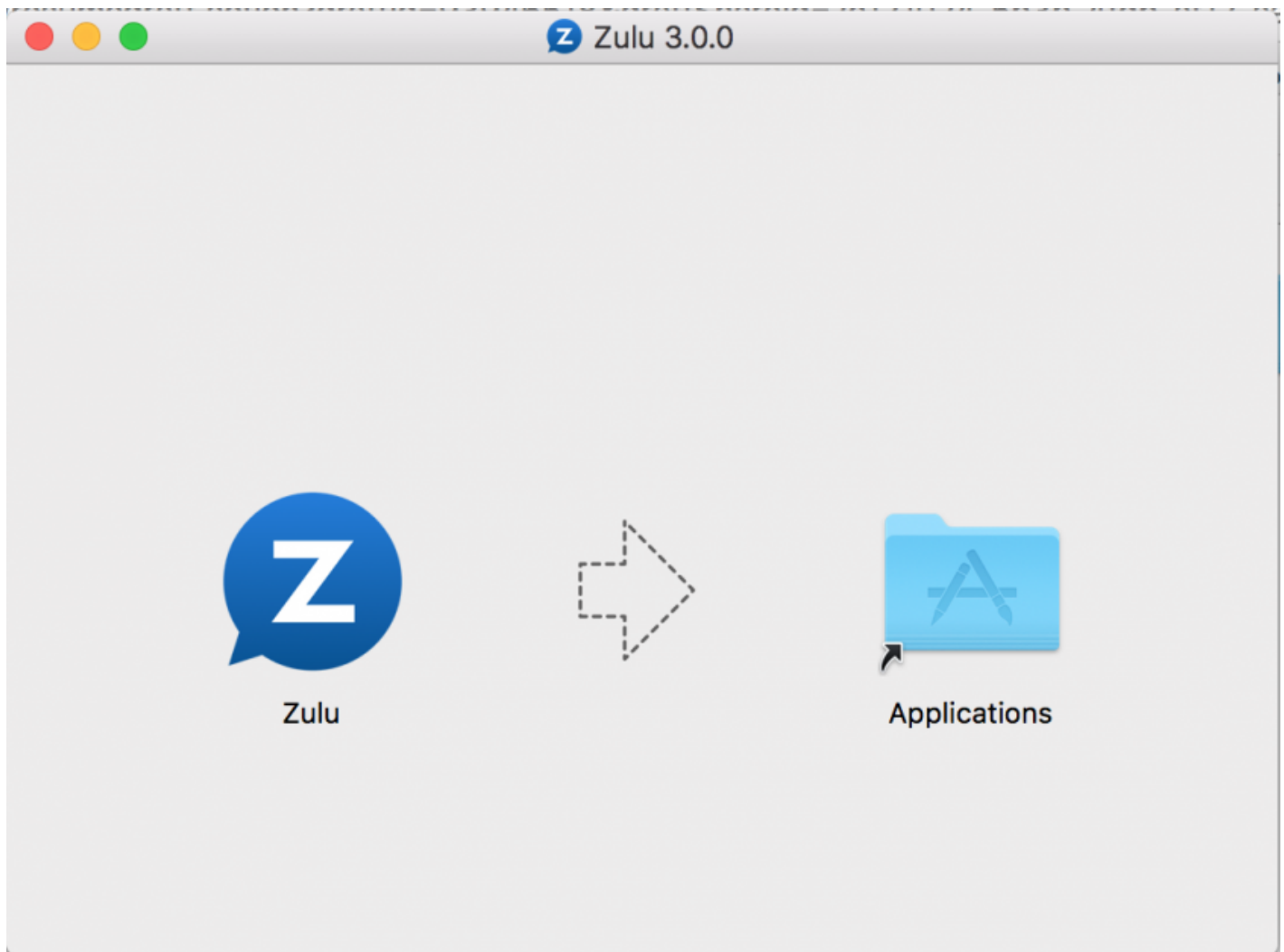
Install on MacOS

Double click on the Zulu-3.x.x.dmg file you downloaded



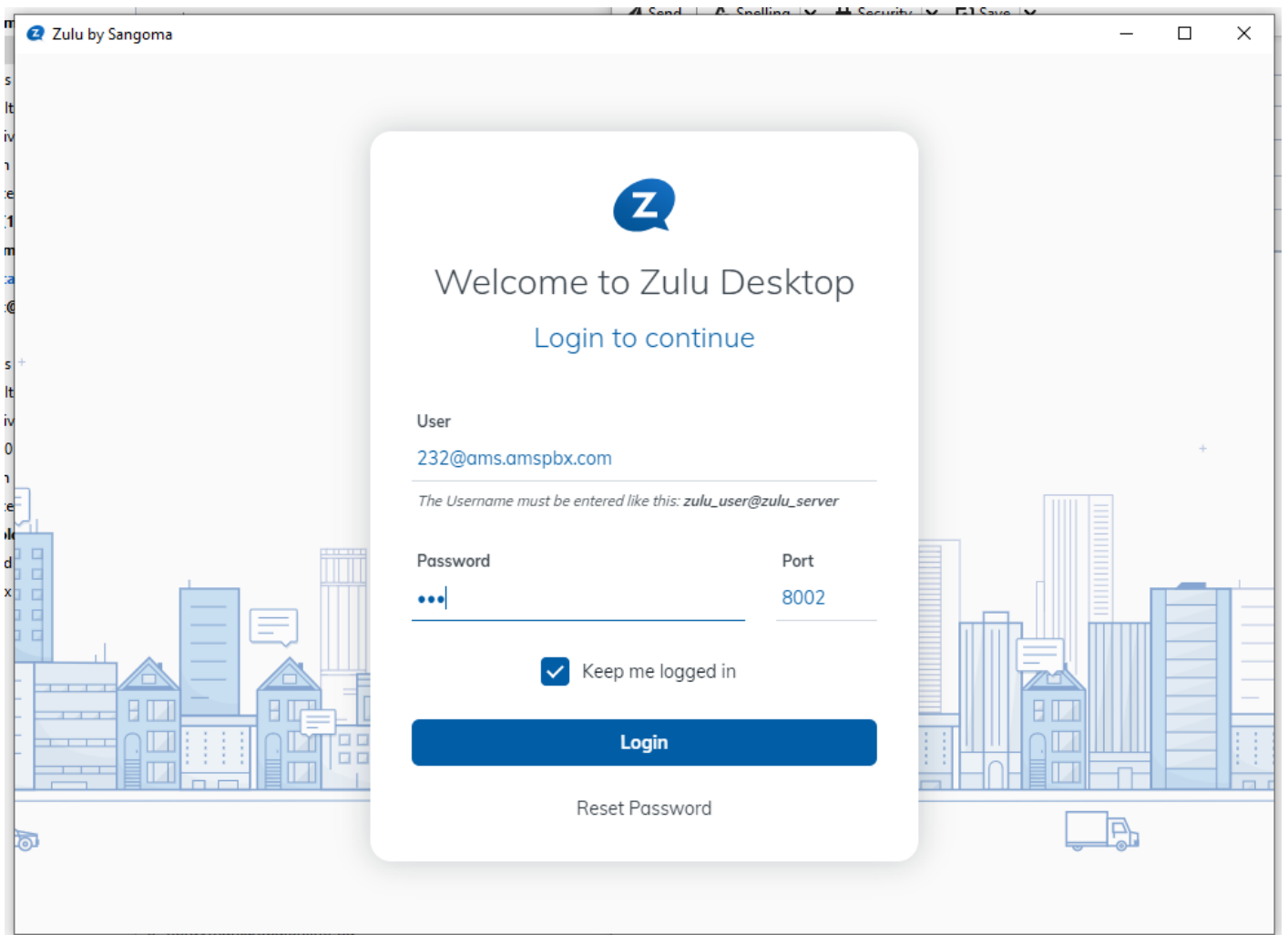
Drag Zulu into the Application Folder
